<u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES</u>: MOTION-A/M COTNOIR, SECOND-A/M TAYLOR TO APPROVE NOVEMBER 13, 2017 MINUTES AS PRESENTED UV

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION: MR. DAVID DENOME, VANDALE ST, PUTNAM ADDRESSED THE AUTHORITY BOARD WITH HIS QUESTIONS ON THE DISTRICT'S CURRENT STATUS WITH TANKO LIGHTING REGARDING STREET LIGHTS. A/C LAJOIE ADVISED MR DENOME THAT ONLY AN AUDIT SURVEY OF STREET LIGHTS HAS BEEN APPROVED. THE BASIC CONCEPT OF LED LIGHTING IS MORE EFFICIENT, LONGER LASTING, AND LESS EXPENSIVE THAN SODIUM LIGHTING THE DISTRICT AUTHORITY IS CURRENTLY WORKING WITH TANKO FOR AN AGREEMENT TO IMPLEMENT LED STREET LIGHTS IN THE SPECIAL SERVICES DISTRICT IF, AND WHEN AN AGREEMENT IS FINALIZED, IT WILL BE BROUGHT TO THE VOTERS OF THE SPECIAL SERVICES DISTRICT TO APPROVE OR REJECT

POLICE OFFICERS INITIATED 58 CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS THAT RESULTED IN 37 ON SITE CUSTODY ARRESTS CONTINUED INVESTIGATIONS WERE REQUIRED ON 21 OF THE REPORTED CRIMES A TOTAL OF 70 CRIMINAL ARRESTS WERE MADE IN NOVEMBER POLICE OFFICERS CONDUCTED 177 MOTOR VEHICLE STOPS. 83 VERBAL WARNINGS, 73 WRITTEN WARNINGS AND 21 CITATIONS WERE ISSUED A TOTAL OF 20 MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS WERE INVESTIGATED
